This third addition to the Old Assyrian Bibliography follows the structure of OAAS 1 [C. Michel, *Old Assyrian Bibliography of Cuneiform Texts, Bullae, Seals and the Results of the Excavations at Aššur, Kültepe/Kaniš, Acemhöyük, Alişar and Boğazköy*, Leiden, 2003], OAB 1 [C. Michel, *Old Assyrian Bibliography 1* (February 2003 - July 2006), *AfO* 51 (2005-2006), p. 436-449] and OAB 2 [C. Michel, *Old Assyrian Bibliography 2* (August 2006 - April 2009), *AfO* 52 (2011), p. 416-437].
